ProductView ECAD Compare and Validate 9.0

ProductView ECAD Compare 9.0


During the development of electromechanical products, designs change (after layout, during manufacturing optimization, and as a result of engineering change orders, among other reasons). Electrical engineers, mechanical engineers, and domain experts have always had to manually identify these changes—until now.


ProductView ECAD Compare (formerly InterComm EDAcompare) greatly simplifies and accelerates the identification of changes between any two versions of the PCB layout, PCB schematic, or manufacturing artwork (Gerber). ProductView ECAD Compare uses both attribute- and image-based comparison


analysis, letting you decide whether a change impacts the design intent and may warrant a more in-depth review.





ProductView Validate 9.0

ProductView Validate (formerly Validation Manager) lets you interactively review the results of a ProductView ECAD Compare comparison. The results of a comparison are saved in an IDX file (compatible with ProductView Validate 9.0). This IDX format is based on the ProSTEP EDMD open schema for incremental exchange of PCB design changes between MCAD and ECAD tools.



A detailed review can be accomplished using various commands in Validate to highlight issues in an external tool (such as Pro/ENGINEER, InterComm Expert, or third-party applications). ProductView Validate is an interactive client application for managing incremental design changes between PCB designs across the ECAD and MCAD domains.

This includes:

- MCAD design issues within Pro/ENGINEER PCB assemblies,
- ECAD design issues within the native ECAD PCB design tools, and

• ECAD-MCAD design issues shared between PCB designs in Pro/ENGINEER and the native ECAD PCB tools

ProductView Validate manages data in the context of two specific processes:

- 1. **Design Compare**—This process is driven by the ProductView ECAD Compare application, which identifies changes between two existing PCB designs revisions. These revisions may be exclusively within the Pro/ENGINEER PCB assemblies, exclusively within the native ECAD PCB tools, or shared between both. The resulting data is an IDX file that contains design differences (transactions).
- 2. **ECAD-MCAD Collaboration**—Driven by a combination of Pro/ENGINEER, ProductView ECAD, and the native ECAD PCB design applications, this process manages incremental changes between the ECAD and MCAD domains as incremental proposals that need to be evaluated by the other domain. The resulting data is an IDX file that contains design change proposals (transactions).





Pro/ENGINEER Wildfire 4.0 now allows you to generate InterComm Expert eda files (**File > Save a Copy**). Why is this so great? It allows you to visualize your 3D mechanical assembly in 2D, which is easier to understand for the PCB Designer. This also enables comparisons between PCB designs and mechanical designs using ProductView ECAD Compare.
